Monitoring report:


- Developing draft monitoring report
- Coordination with project participants, TPEs and both sides' governments to submit necessary documents for each procedural step





IGES involvement for Methodology Development




IGES involved methodologies




- ➤ IGES proposed <u>5 methodologies (solar PV)</u> as a methodology proponent.
- 2 methodologies (Mongolia and Cambodia) have been approved.



IGES involvement for Registration




IGES involved PDDs




- ➤ IGES has involved development of PDDs for 27 projects with technical assistance including how to fill in the information.
- Estimated ERs by 2020 from 16 JCM projects (Registered and under validation) are 73 thousand t CO₂.



IGES involvement for Issuance of JCM Credits




IGES involved monitoring reports



➤ IGES has involved with development of monitoring reports for 11 projects with technical assistance including how to fill in the information (5 projects have issued JCM credits (493 tCO₂ in total).

Registry Development

- IGES assisted developing the JCM registry system for Indonesia, Mongolia, Palau and Vietnam, as per the requests.
- In order to issue the JCM credits smoothly, the operation manual was also prepared for 4 countries.
- Suppose there are always technical errors in software, need to update existing JCM registry systems continuously.



Lessons learned in FY2016

- ➤ It is important to secure opportunities for discussing proposed methodologies with JCM partner countries.
- Local Stakeholder Consultation (LSC) is one of the important process in JCM partner countries in developing Project Design Documents (PDDs)
- Continuous checking of JCM rules (revision of rules, guidelines and forms etc) are needed by project participants.
- Lessons leaned from development of methodologies and PDDs etc should be shared among relevant stakeholders for further implementation of the JCM.
